



The "Digital Communication in the 21st Century" training programme, held at the Technical University of Cartagena (UPCT) in Spain, aimed to enhance participants' digital communication skills. The programme focused on improving writing and oral presentation skills in digital environments, as well as honing social, interpersonal, and teamwork abilities within a multicultural setting. The training, which lasted for five days, included a series of lectures, seminars, debates, case studies, and team-building activities, all designed to engage participants and help them apply the skills they were learning.
