



The English for Engineers program aimed to improve participants' communication skills and English proficiency, focusing on specialized vocabulary for professional interactions. It also included role-playing, seminars, and debates to enhance vocabulary, writing, and soft skills.

The Career Panel facilitated interaction between students and employers, offering valuable insights into the labor market and supporting students' networking skills. Industry representatives shared key skills and knowledge sought in mechanical engineering, helping students prepare for future career challenges. The panel also provided opportunities to improve job interview skills, with master classes on making strong first impressions.

The activities produced valuable materials for future training, including manuals and the Public Speaking Handbook for Engineers, which is designed to improve public speaking skills for both engineers and non-engineers. Below are links of relating to publications and other dissemination materials.

The project website, the presentations skills from Cartagena training and the two modules (Career Panel and ESP for Engineers from Dresden training) have been disseminated together with TPG at TU Dresden at our Engineering Faculty and Faculty of Foreign Languages and Culture in addition to representatives from Saxon Ministry of Education.
