1. Hackathon:

From 19 to 23 February, the Soft Skills department of Léonard de Vinci is organizing a week-long hackathon on a specific theme. This year's theme is "Artificial Intelligence and its social challenges".

Throughout the week, students from the "success" group and five students from ESILV will work together on this topic and two experts will lead the success group.

The week ends with an oral presentation of a project to a jury on Friday.

Hackathon topics:

- Ecology: climate, biodiversity, sustainable food, dwindling natural resources, etc.
- CSR: Diversity and inclusion in business, the ideal employer, impact entrepreneurship, etc.
- Technology and SD: Low-Tech, Responsible Innovation, Digital Hyperconnection, etc.
- Society: Digital for the Disabled, Sustainable and Responsible Sport, etc.

The soft skills department will provide you with more information later about expectations, instructions, and the subjects to be covered.

2. GENERAL FOLLOW UP

Meeting to take stock of the various projects carried out.

Each university makes a presentation of the projects carried out for this project.

Students will be asked to give their feedback on these projects during this meeting.

SUCCESS is an ERASMUS initiative to strengthen language teaching, especially English, for engineering students. The project involves four partner institutions: Riga Technical University (RTU), Technical University Dresden, UPCT (Universidad Politecnica Cartagena) and the Leonard de Vinci Association in Paris, France.

Every six months, a host university welcomes the partner universities, each of which selects five engineering students. The aim of each university is to implement measures to improve English language learning and to evaluate the results.
